The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) and the Respondent,
City of Benkelman, voluntarily enter into this Amended Consent Order. The
previously entered Consent Order in this case shall stay in full force and effect,
except paragraph 14, which is amended to the following:

"14. The Parties agree as follows:

- A. By February 1, 2013, the Respondent will fix problems associated with the lift station, correct operational problems and report to the Department identifying measures taken to identify and repair the collection system to remove excessive infiltration/inflow.
- B. By June 1, 2013, the Respondent shall submit a progress assessment report to the Department detailing operations of the system over the last year. The progress assessment must include:
 - 1. An analysis of the probability that further operational measures will successfully deal with specific issues of non-compliance (Ammonia, CBOD, TSS) and

- 2. An outline of the further operational measures that the Respondent will enact to bring the wastewater lagoons into compliance.
- C. By July 1, 2013, The Respondent shall submit to the Department for approval detailed plans and specifications for all necessary upgrades required to come into compliance with the statutes and regulations.
- D. By September 1, 2013, the Respondent shall begin construction on the upgrades to the wastewater system in accordance with the approved plans and specifications.
- E. By April 1, 2014, the Respondent shall place in operation a wastewater system which is in compliance with the statutes and regulations."
