The Nebraska Department of Environmental Quality ("NDEQ") and Terry L. Jessen ("Jessen") jointly filed this Consent For Release of Funds Pursuant to the Settlement Release and Satisfaction, and each party having consented to the making and entering of this Consent without trial, the Court finds that the Consent for Release of Funds should be and hereby is entered.

- 1. This Court has jurisdiction of the parties and the subject matter of this action pursuant to the Nebraska Environmental Protection Act, Neb. Rev. Stat. § 81-1501 et seq. (Reissue 2014), and all rules, regulations, and orders promulgated and issued thereunder.
- 2. NDEQ alleged that Jessen et al failed to properly obtain coverage under the National Pollutant

 Discharge Elimination System Construction Storm Water General Permit (NER110000) prior to beginning construction

 of a hotel project near Gothenburg, Nebraska. Jessen et al specifically denies the same.
- 3. NDEQ and Jessen et al agree that settlement of this matter is in the public interest and that entry of this Consent is the most appropriate means of resolving their dispute. NDEQ and Jessen et al desire to conclude this case without trial or adjudication of any issue of fact or law, without this Consent constituting an admission by Jessen et al with respect to such issues.
- 4. The Consent shall be in full satisfaction of all claims alleged Complaint. NDEQ and Jessen agree to release all claims arising out the same transaction or occurrences referenced in the Complaint, provided such claims were known, or were reasonably ascertainable from information within the parties' possession, as of the date of the entry of the Consent:

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5. Entry of this Consent will have no effect on any enforcement action brought by the State or NDEQ against Jessen et al for future violations of any statues or regulations.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- Terry Jessen et al shall pay a compromised settlement, with Jessen et al denying liability. Jessen et al shall pay the amount of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) as a compromised settlement. The proceeds are being accepted by the plaintiff as a civil penalty for distribution as provided in Article VII, Section V, of the Nebraska Constitution and will be paid within fifteen (15) days of the date of the Court signing this order.
- 7. The plaintiff herein shall sign the separate Release and Satisfaction prepared by the de fendant.
 - This action is otherwise hereby dismissed with prejudice.
