
Pursuant to paragraph 18 of the Consent Order entered on August 18, 2021, the parties mutually agree that paragraph 18 of the Order be modified and amended to include the addition of subparagraph 'a' below. All other paragraphs and subparagraphs of the August 18, 2021, Consent Order remain in effect.

18.a. AMENDMENT 1. In the event the present national disruption to hazardous waste treatment, storage, and disposal services extends until Offutt Air Force Base flight operations have returned from the Lincoln Airport after Offutt runway reconstruction, any remaining hazardous waste accumulated at the Lincoln Airport under U.S. EPA/NDEE Site Identification# NE0000331629 may be managed under a one-time transport and consolidation of waste from the Lincoln Airport to Offutt Air Force Base provided that: 1) a transporter of hazardous waste meeting the requirements of NDEE Title 128, Chapter 11 – "Requirements for Transporters of Hazardous Waste" is used, and 2) all hazardous waste storage containers transported and 90-day hazardous waste accumulation & storage areas at Offutt Air Force Base receiving hazardous waste from the Lincoln Airport continue to be managed in accordance with the requirements of the August 18, 2021, Consent Order and NDEE Title 128.


