- It is (or will be) used in or on a piece of equipment that is intended to be propelled while performing its function.
- It is portable or transportable, meaning designed to be and capable of being carried or moved from one location to another. Characterizations of transportability include, but are not limited to, wheels, skids, carrying handles, dolly, trailer, or platform.

An internal combustion engine is not a nonroad engine if it meets any of the following criteria:

- The engine is regulated under 40 CFR part 60 or otherwise regulated by a federal New Source Performance Standard
- Any engine (including any engine intended to replace it and perform a similar function) that would otherwise be considered a nonroad source that will remain at a location for more than 12 consecutive months or a shorter period of time for an engine located at a seasonal source. A location is any single site at a building, structure, facility, or installation.
