The name and address of the dismantler			
<ol> <li>Identification of the old vehicle and engine including model year, VIN, and engine serial number</li> </ol>			
<ol><li>The dates the vehicle was accepted and scrapped by the dismantler.</li></ol>

Scrappage may be completed by the rebate recipient or by a salvage yard, or similar service, provided all scrappage requirements have been met and all necessary documentation is provided. The rebate recipient is responsible for ensuring that the required scrappage photographs are acquired and submitted. Equipment and vehicle components that are not part of the engine or chassis may be salvaged from the unit being replaced (e.g. seats, tires, etc.). If scrapped or salvaged parts are to be sold, the resulting income may be retained by the rebate recipient but must be reported to NDEQ as program income.  Salvage Income: \$
