

ORDINANCE NO. 01-305

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING SAFEGUARDS TO PROTECT THE CITY WATER SOURCES FROM CONTAMINATION.

WHEREAS, the City of Hay Springs, Nebraska has water wells that provide drinking water for consumption by the residents of the Municipality, and;

WHEREAS, it is determined and declared to be necessary and conducive to the protection of the public health, safety, welfare, and convenience of the city to enact an ordinance providing for the continued safety of the city water source from possible contamination.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Hay Springs, Nebraska as follows:

Section 1 That Chapter 4, Article 1, Health and Sanitation, of the Hay Springs City Code be amended.

Section 2. That Chapter 4, Article 1, Section 105 read as follows:

§ 4-105 Health; Protection of Water Source. For the purpose of promoting the health and safety of the residents of the municipality, and the protection of the municipal water source from possible contamination, the city shall comply with all rules and regulations of the Nebraska Department of Health and the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services, including, but not limited to Chapter 2, Title 179, Attachment 1, and Chapter 12, Title 178, and any other rule, regulation, standard, or statute of the State of Nebraska or the United States of America as those relate to the protection of the municipal water supply from surface water contamination and from seepage from sources of contamination and pollution.

Section 3 This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
